



The office of the Director students' welfare, Junagadh Agricultural University, Junagadh was established with effect from 09.08.2004 after existence of Junagadh Agricultural University. This office is looking after various students' activities/facilities including sports, culture, fellowships, residential, recreation, health, adventure, counselling placement etc. More over, dignitaries of different fields are invited to share their thoughts, experiences and views among staff and students.

### 6.1 Students Union

In the colleges of Junagadh Agricultural University, the Student Representative Council (SRC) formed by Principal of respective colleges by selecting the sincere and leading students in sports, culture, debate and adventure activities. The Principal also nominate the Chairman and staff advisors. Principal acts as president of SRC. During 2005-06, 14 advisors and 13 students' representatives were nominated in College of Agricultural Engineering & Technology, while 8 staff advisors and 12 students' representatives were approved in College of Fisheries Science, Veraval.

### 6.2 Students facilities

All the undergraduate and postgraduate students are provided hostel facilities with an attached mess. A central library near the hostel area is utilised by students for reference, reading and net surfing. A sports complex also exists near the hostels and interested students utilize the facilities according to their choice of games. After inception of Junagadh Agricultural University two modern volleyball grounds are prepared surrounded with fencing and flood light facilities.

A Student Counselling and Placement Cell is working in the university. During 2005-06 campus interviews were arranged by State Bank group and 14 students of Agriculture faculty and 16 students of Agricultural Engineering faculty were selected. While 10 students of Fisheries Science faculty were selected in different institutes through Placement Cell.

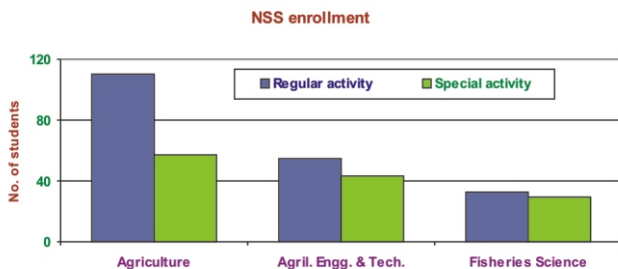


### (3) College of Fisheries Science

### 6.7 Educational Tour

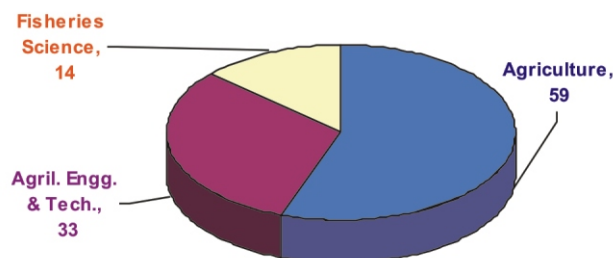
The colleges of Junagadh Agricultural University are conducting the educational tour under RAWE programme every year. The aim of this tour is to show directly the location specific activities of research and

## 6.8 Financial Assistance to Students

In Junagadh Agricultural University, the following scholarships are awarded to the students.

### 1. National Talent Scholarship (NTS)

Awarded to students of other states nominated by ICAR on the basis of merit and written test @ Rs. 1200 per student per annum. During the period, 16 students received this scholarship.

### 2. Merit cum Means Scholarship (MCM)

Awarded by ICAR to five meritorious students in each faculty. The amount of this scholarship is Rs. 2040 per student per annum. During the period not a single student received this scholarship.





### 3. JAU UG Scholarship

Awarded by Junagadh Agricultural University to five girl students in each faculty @ Rs. 6000 per student per annum. If girl candidates are not available, it is awarded to economically backward students on the basis of merit.

### 4. PG Scholarship

Awarded by Junagadh Agricultural University on the basis of merit to four students for Master degree and two students for Ph.D. @ Rs. 12000 and Rs. 18000, respectively.

### 5. Merit & Poor Merit Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to economically backward students by the Department of Social Welfare of the state @ Rs. 720 per student. During the report period, 16 students received this scholarship.
