


# STUDENTS' WELFARE



#### 6.1 Director, Students' Welfare:

Director, Students' Welfare is responsible for making arrangements for lodging, boarding and welfare of the students and coordinates various cocurricular activities such as arrangement of Inter Collegiate, Inter University and National level Sports tournaments, literary and cultural competitions, and also implements various activities of National Service Scheme as Programme Coordinator (NSS) other than the academic work. The Directorate facilitates the students of outgoing batches in finding the suitable placement based on their caliber. Students of JAU get employment though placement in National and Multinational agro-based companies, Universities, Department of Agriculture, Horticulture, banks, agricultural engineering firms; NGO's are a few among them. Directorate of Students Welfare serves as a hub of students' guidance, counseling and placement, financial assistance, Students' discipline activities for all its constituent colleges and Polytechnics. The ultimate objective is to groom the students to become good citizens of country by personality and skills development for better living. The DSW office also comprises different cadre official's assigned additional duties from other departments for welfare activities. The Directorate organizes frequent motivational talks by eminent personalities as well as by alumni of Junagadh Agricultural University who have proved their mettle in various field of agriculture. It also helps the students in facing the challenges of life by conducting mock group discussions and interviews, Students' Parliament when it launches, Quiz contests, etc. The Campus to Corporate workshops, various training programmes on Leadership, Entrepreneurship, Personality and communication skills Development for the holistic development of the Students also conducts by the Directorate. In addition to the above various special programme assigned by State Government like Voter awareness Programme, Swachch Bharat Mission, International Yoga Day,

Woman Empowerment Programme, Health awareness programmes are carried out.

#### 6.2 Students' Union:

The Student Representative Council (SRC) is constituted by the Principals of respective Colleges by selecting the sincere and leading students in sports, culture, debate, adventure activities, NSS activities, students' trainings and residential activities. The Principal acts as a President of SRC of respective College and nominates the Chairman, Students' Representative Council, and staff advisors of the respective College after obtaining approval from the Director, Students' Welfare.

#### 6.3 Students' facilities:

All the undergraduate and post graduate students are provided with hostel facilities with an attached mess. Various hostel facilities exist for the students of Different faculties, in addition to this, an International hostel for foreign students is available, Dolphin and Sarswati hostels for Fisheries College, Veraval, Kalapi and Sarswati hostels for College of Agriculture, Mota Bhandariya are in use. As a part of the residential facility, more hostels like 'Vikas' for Horticulture College, Mahatma Gandhi hostel for Post Graduate of Agriculture, Zaverchand Meghani Hostel at Dhari, are in use. While, Riddhi and Siddhi girls hostels having capacity of 210 and 132 girls are also available at Junagadh. There are total 29 hostels, 21 for boys and 8 for girls having capacity to accommodate 2612 students. Looking to the increasing strength of the students one more hostels are under construction at College of Agriculture, JAU, Khapat.

University library situated near the hostel area is utilized by students for reference, reading and net surfing. A sport complex exists near the hostels for the carrying out extra co-curricular activities for the students. Two grounds for Kabaddi and Kho-Kho are available with flood light facilities. A multipurpose Indoor Sports Stadium at par with National Standards is also available for indoor sports. The solar street



lights are installed in premises of sports complex for night time practice of sports.

#### **Students' Counseling and Placement:**

Student counseling and Placement Cell is constituted for the betterment of students with a committed view to provide exposure and opportunities to the students to the corporate world. Director of Students' Welfare coordinates and monitors the activities of Student Counseling and Placement cell functioning in all the constituent colleges of the Junagadh Agricultural University. Student Counseling and Placement cell is functioning

under the Director, Students' Welfare with objectives to maintain data base of the students of outgoing batch and to keep in constant touch with various employers for conducting campus interview for providing better placement opportunity. The Directorate also arrange special lectures and short term training on Personality Development and life skills, communication skills, Leadership,, Entrepreurship development and resume preparation for the students of all the faculties, so as to built the self esteem of the students which enable them to face the challenges with confidence.

#### 6.4 Physical Education Programme:

The University also emphasis on the activities of games and sports with objectives *viz;* to keep the students physically efficient, mentally alert, morally sound and socially well behaved.
