Hon'ble Vice Chancellor's Message

Pearl Millet a Nutricereal Smart Food

Wishing all a very happy, healthy and prosperous New Year 2022! Pearl millet [Pennisetumglaucum (L.) R. Br.] is the most widely grown staple food of majority of poor and small land holders in Asia and Africa. It is also consumed as feed and fodder for livestock. It accounts for almost half of global millet production. The major pearl millet growing states are Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat and Haryana contributing 90% of total national production. It is critically important for food and nutritional security as it possesses



several advantages such as early maturing, drought tolerance, require minimal purchase of inputs and mostly free from biotic and abiotic stresses.

Due to the excellent nutritional properties and resilience to climate change, pearl millet along with other millets is renamed as nutricereals (Gazette of India, No. 133 dt 13 April, 2018) for production, consumption, trade and was included in public distribution system. To bring millets into mainstream for exploiting the nutritional rich properties and promoting their cultivation, Govt. of India declared Year 2018 as the "Year of Millets" and by request of India; the FAO of the United Nations Organization has declared the year 2023 as "International Year of Millets".

The work of pearl millet improvement was started in 1962 in third five-year plan. In 1963, Jamnagar got assistance from The Rockefeller Foundation by way of Germplasm male sterile American Bajri. This was the real beginning of the improvement of Bajra work not only in Gujarat state but also in India and this is a turning point in the history of pearl millet improvement in India. The journey of development of hybrid variety and other pearl millet technology started with development of First hybrid HB 2 in 1965 immediately followed by HB 3 and since then earstwhile GAU and JAU has developed total 26 hybrids suitable under varied agro-climatic condition of India. Genetic biofortification is a way of enhancing nutrition in staple crops in the modern period, and improved food processing and markets will be the backbone of future nutritional security. Hence, breeding of micronutrient-rich pearl millet varieties and their utilization would fulfill the recommended dietary allowance of Fe and Zn and would encourage producing biofortified pearl millet lines. Looking to this, JAU carried out pioneering work for the development of micronutrients dense pearl millet hybrids and is recommended for cultivation, the states first biofortified pearl millet hybrids GHB 1129 and GHB 1225 which were identified in the year 2018 among the all field, horticulture and vegetable crops in SAUs of Gujarat.

Further, one more feather in the JAU crown added by carring out pioneer work in the field of marker assisted breeding by Pearl Millet Research Station, Jamnagar in collaboration with ICRISAT, Hyderabad by developing the state's first pearl millet hybrid GHB 538 improved (MaruSona) by using modern biotech tool MAS which is first across the different crops among all SAUs of Gujarat. In this hybrid, we have introduced the downey mildew diseases resistance genes in one of the parental line of our earlier released pearl millet hybrid GHB 538. Pearl millet is a Nutricereal smart food, Let's join smart food campaign because smart food is good for us, for the planet and also for the farmers.

Agri Gujarat Expo-2021

The Agri Gujarat Expo-2021 was jointly organized by Junagadh Agricultural University, Junagadh and Spark Media Inc., Ahmedabad from November 19 to 21, 2021 at JAU, Junagadh. The agricultural exhibition was organized under Agri Gujarat Expo-2021 spread across 2500 sq. m. The technologies were exhibited in 70 stalls of different agriculture and allied companies, 13 stalls of different departments of JAU, Junagadh and 04 stalls of natural farming.









The Seminar on the use of modern technology in agriculture was organized on November 20, 2021. The JAU scientists delivered lectures on new dimensions of modern technology in agriculture; mango export oriented farming method, scientific animal husbandry business to earn more income, skill development, startup, FPO, agro tourism and use of artificial intelligence in pest control.
